Sandra Dučić is an independent scholar and translator who has studied Classical Philology in ex-Yugoslavia (Novi-Sad), Canada (Université de Montréal), Germany (DAAD), and Austria (Universität Wien). As a Culture Communication Fund B.V. Fellow (2004-2005), she also did research on the ancient Japanese conception of gardens (in the Japanese court of the Heian period) at the International Research Institute for the Humanities in Nichibunken (Kyoto, Japan). She has a wide range of research interests and expertise, from ancient concepts of love and the influence of Plato on Hölderlin and Shelley. In addition to classical (Greek and Latin) themes, her current research interests embrace several themes in the history of art and literature, in addition to classical (Greek and Latin) themes, including the poetry of Dante and of the Romantic movement as well as the aesthetic theories of Raphael and Castiglione. She is currently translating into Serbian several studies by C.L. Frommel on Raphael and Pope Julius II, as well as poetry by Shelley and poet and ambassador Jovan Dučić (currant project with “Aracne”, Rome).
